WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS August 17, 2021

The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. August 17, 2021 adjourned from August 10, 2021.

Present: Supervisors Smith, Durby and Jensvold
Absent:

The meeting is held today via You Tube and a conference call. This is due to COVID-19 and heightened public health risks.

On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the August 10, 2021 Board Meeting and the agenda for August 17, 2021. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Smith and seconded by Jensvold the Supervisors moved to approve the temporary IT contract with Eric Guth. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the 28E agreement with Homeward Inc. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Scott Meinders, Engineer discussed Secondary roads including, crushing asphalt at Sunnyside pit, painting, and auction of bridge lumber.

Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed drainage matters including DD 5 Lat 19. A petition had been filed to annex in a private ditch to the district. The result is leaving the private ditch private. Engineering fees were levied to DD 5 Lat 19. The Board of Supervisors, acting as Trustees will discuss this next week to see who should have been levied.

Rick Hopper, Jacobson Westergard discussed DD 11 Lower Main Engineer report including the cost of mitigating the acres to straighten the waterway. The cost to straighten would be between \$600,000 and \$1,250,000. The cost to clean the waterway and add riprap would be between \$135,000 and \$140,000. Oswald asked to have an informational hearing and send letters to the land owners. On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to have an informational meeting on September 7, 2021 at 9:30 A.M. All voted aye. Motion carried.

At 9:30 A.M. on a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to open the Final Public Hearing for DD 18 Lat 11. Present at the hearing was Supervisors Durby, Jensvold and Smith, Karla Weiss, Auditor, Scott Meinders, Engineer, Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk, Rick Hopper, Jacobson Westergard, and Mar

Borcharding, by phone. The project was discussed. On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to close the Final Public Hearing. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to set the Public Hearing for Norway 10 East Site Master Matrix for September 7, 2021 at 9:15 A.M. All voted aye. Motion carried.
