RESOLUTION NO. 05-18-2021-01-02

Resolution authorizing and approving a Loan Agreement and providing for the issuance of a \$3,340,000 General Obligation Refunding Note, Series 2021

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of Winnebago County. Iowa (the "County"), has previously issued its \$4,240,000 General Obligation Public Safety Center Bonds. Series 2016B. (the "2016 Bonds") a portion of which currently remains outstanding; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the resolution (the "2016B Bond Resolution") authorizing the issuance of the 2016B Bonds, the County reserved the right to call the portion of the 2016B Bonds maturing in the vears 2022 through 2035, inclusive (the "Callable 2016B Bonds"), for early redemption on any date on or after June 1, 2021, subject to the provisions of the 2016B Bond Res-

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 331.402 of the Code of Iowa, the Board has heretofore proposed to contract indebtedness and enter into a loan agreement (the "Loan Agreement") in a principal amount not to exceed \$3,340,000, for the purpose of paying the cost, to that extent, of refunding the outstanding balance of the Callable 2016B Bonds and has published notice of the proposed action and has held a hearing there-

WHEREAS, the Board has accepted a proposal from Titonka Savings Bank, Titonka, Iowa (the "Bank") for the purchase of a \$3.340.000 General Obligation Refunding Note, Series 2021 (the "Note") in evidence of the obligation of the County under the Loan Agreement, and it is necessary at this time to authorize and approve the Loan Agreement, to make provision for the issuance the Note and to provide for the early redemption of the Callable 2016B Bonds:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Winnebago County, Iowa, as fol-

Section 1. The Board determines to enter into the Loan Agreement with the Bank, providing for a loan to the County in the principal amount of \$3,340,000 for the purpose set forth in the preamble here-

The Chairperson and County Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to sign the Loan Agreement on behalf of the County, and the Loan Agreement is hereby ap-

Section 2. The Note is hereby authorized to be issued in evidence of the obligation of the County under the Loan Agreement, in the principal amount of \$3,340,000 for the purpose set forth in the preamble hereof.

The County Auditor is hereby designated as the registrar and paving agent for the Note and may be hereinafter referred to as the "Registrar" or the "Paying Agent."

Interest on the Note shall be paid at the rate of 1.547% per annum. Both principal of and interest on the Note shall be paid in semi-annual installments on June 1 and December 1 of each year, beginning December 1, 2021, and continuing until December 1, 2034, in the amount of \$133,128.03 each, with one final installment of all remaining principal and interest to be paid on June 1,

Payment of both principal of and interest on the Note shall be made to the registered owner appearing on the registration books of the County at the close of business on the fifteenth day of the month next preceding the payment date and shall be paid by electronic means, or check or draft mailed to the registered owner at the address shown on such registration books; provided, however, that the final installment of principal and interest shall be payable only upon presentation and surrender of the Note to the Paying Agent.

The County reserves the right to prepay principal of the Note in whole or in part on any date prior to and in inverse order of maturity on terms of par and accrued interest, provided notice is sent to the holder of the Note at least 30 days prior to the date of redemption. All principal so prepaid shall cease to bear interest on the prepayment date.

The Note shall be executed on behalf of the County which the official manual or facsimile signature of the Chairperson and attested by the official manual or facsimile signature of the County Auditor and shall be a fully registered Note without interest coupons. In case any officer whose signature or the facsimile of whose signature appears on the Note shall cease to be such officer before the delivery of the Note, such signature or such facsimile signature shall nevertheless be valid and sufficient for all purposes, the same as if such officer had remained in office until delivery.

The Note shall be fully registered as to principal and interest in the name of the owner on the registration books of the County kept by the Registrar, and after such registration, payment of the principal thereof and interest thereon shall be made only to the registered owner or its legal representative or assigns. The Note shall be transferable without cost to the registered owner thereof only upon the registration books of the County upon presentation to the Registrar together with either a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the Registrar or an assignment form duly executed by the registered owner or the duly authorized attorney for such registered owner.

The interest or principal and both of them falling due in any year or years shall, if necessary, be paid promptly from current funds on hand in advance of taxes levied and when the taxes shall have been collected, reimbursement shall be made to such current funds in the sum thus advanced.

Section 8. UMB Bank, n.a., West Des Moines, Iowa, as the Registrar for the Callable Series 2016B Bonds, is hereby authorized to take all action necessary to call the Callable 2016B Bonds for redemption on June 21, 2021 (the "Redemption Date"), and is further authorized and directed to give notice of such redemption by sending notice to each of the registered owners of the Callable 2016B Bonds to be redeemed at the addresses shown on the County's registration books, not less than 30 days prior to the Redemption Date and in accordance with the terms of the 2016B Bond Resolution.

Section 9. It is the intention of the County that interest on the Note be and remain excluded from gross Supplies. income for federal income tax purposes pursuant to the appropriate -Parts . provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the -Parts .. Treasury Regulations in effect with respect thereto (all of the foregoing herein referred to as the "Internal Revenue Code"). In furtherance thereof, the County covenants to comply with the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code as they may from time to time be in effect or amended and further covenants to comply with the applicable future Albert Lee Seed House laws, regulations, published rulings and court decisions as may be necessary to insure that the interest on the Note will remain excluded from -Supplies

gross income for federal income tax purposes. Any and all of the officers of the County are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions as may be necessary to comply with the covenants herein contained.

The County hereby designates the Note as a "Qualified Tax Exempt Obligation" as that term is used in Section 265(b)(3)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code. Section 10. All resolutions or
