RESOLUTION #10-06-220-03-001 RESOLUTION FOR POSTPONEMENT OF TAX SALE UNDER IOWA CODE CHAPTER 446

WITHIN WINNEBAGO COUNTY

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors of Winnebago County, Iowa and Governor of the State of Iowa, have declared a state of emergency caused by the COVID-19 viral pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Winnebago County Treasure has made attempts to hold the tax sale required under Iowa Code 446, and specifically under Iowa Code 446-28, that the June tax sale be held on the succeeding month unless good cause is shown; and

WHEREAS, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and the inability to hold either an in-person tax sale due to the number of individuals that would be present or online tax sale due to technological limitations, good cause is found that the tax sale should be postponed for the month of October.

WHEREAS, the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors and Winnebago County Treasurer that good cause exists that a tax sale cannot be held under Iowa Code 446-28 due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and is postponed for the month of October.

APPROVE BOND PURCHASE AGREEMENT AND CALL OUTSTANDING BONDS FOR PREPARATION 452737-11

Forest City, Iowa October 6, 2020

It was reported that the County had received a proposal from Northland Securities, Inc. for the purchase of the County's General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2020A.

Supervisor Durby introduced the resolution hereinafter next set out and moved that the resolution be adopted, seconded by Supervisor Stensrud. After due consideration, the Chairpersons put the question on the motion and the roll being called, the following named Supervisors voted:

Whereupon, the Chairperson declared the resolution duly adopted, as hereinafter set out.

RESOLUTION NO. 10-6-2020-02-01 Resolution approving Bond Purchase Agreement for General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2020A and providing for early redemption of outstanding General Obligation Bonds.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of Winnebago County, Iowa (the "County"), has previously issued \$6,310,000 (General Obligation Urban Renewal County Road Improvement and Refunding Bonds, Series 2012A Bonds); and

WHEREAS, in the resolution authorizing the issuance of the Series 2012A Bonds, the County reserved the right to call for payment prior to maturity any or all of the Series 2012A Bonds maturing after June 1, 2019 (the "Callable Series 2012A Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the County intends to enter into a General Obligation Refunding Loan Agreement (the "Loan Agreement") and to issue General Obligation Refunding Bonds (the "Series 2020A Bonds"); and WHEREAS, it has been proposed that the County enter into the Loan Agreement with Northland Securities, Inc. Minneapolis, MN (the "Underwriter") and issue the Series 2020A Bonds; and

WHEREAS, a Bond Purchase Agreement (the "Bond Purchase Agreement") has been prepared setting forth the terms of the Series 2020A Bonds and the understanding between the County and the Underwriter, and it is now necessary to make provision for the approval of the Bond Purchase Agreement and to authorize the early redemption of the Callable Series 2012A Bonds;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Winnebago County, as follows:

Section 1. The Bond Purchase Agreement is hereby approved in substantially the form as presented to this Board. The Chairperson and County Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Bond Purchase Agreement to the Underwriter.

Section 2. UMB Bank, n.a., West Des Moines, Iowa, as Registrar and Paying Agent for the Callable Series 2012A Bonds, is hereby authorized to take all action necessary to call the Callable Series 2012A Bonds for redemption as of November 10, 2020 (the "Redemption Date"), and is further authorized and directed to give notice of such redemption by sending notice to each of the registered owners of the Callable Series 2012A Bonds to be redeemed at the address shown on the County's registration books.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

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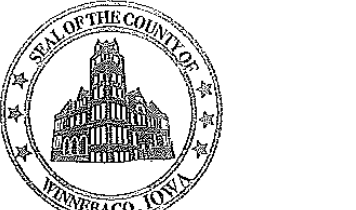
