

## PROCEEDINGS: Winnebago County

### WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS August 25, 2020

The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. August 25, 2020 adjourned from August 18, 2020.

Present: Supervisors Stensrud, Jensvold, and Durby

Absent:  
The meeting is held today via You Tube and a conference call. This is due to COVID-19 and heightened public health risks.

On a motion by Stensrud and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the August 18, 2020 Board Meeting and approve the Agenda for August 25, 2020. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Jeff Heil and Heidi Kuhl, Northland Securities discussed refunding of bonds.

Andy Buffington, Emergency Management gave an update regarding Covid-19. On a motion by Durby and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to approve the following changes to the Winnebago County, Iowa Infectious Disease Action Plan. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Do Not Enter a Winnebago County facility and seek an evaluation from a medical provider if:

- If you are experiencing ANY TWO of the following unexplained minor symptoms,

- Fever – over 100 degrees Fahrenheit
- Headache
- Muscle and body aches
- Fatigue
- Sore throat
- Runny nose
- Congestion
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea

- If you are experiencing ANY of the following High-Risk Symptoms

- New Cough
- Shortness of Breath or difficulty breathing

- New loss of taste or smell

- Have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and/or tested positive for COVID-19. You may not return to work until 24 hours has passed with no fever (without the use of fever-reducing medicine) AND symptoms are improving AND 10 days since your positive test date or symptoms started.

- If you have been within 6 feet for someone who tested positive for COVID 19 for 15 continuous minutes or more. You may not return to work for 14 days AND 24 hours has passed with no fever (without the use of fever-reducing medicine) AND symptoms are improving.

Employees experiencing any of the above should report it immediately. Employees should call their supervisor to report these conditions.

Matt Duve, Zoning Administrator answered questions regarding special use permits regarding Wind Turbines.

Scott Meinders, Engineer discussed secondary road matters including Rognes Brothers working on bridges, Mathy is working on cold in place recycling, secondary road crew is working on pipe replacement and rock hauling is almost completed.

Scott Meinders, Engineer and Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed a ditch stuff in within a road ditch in DD 6 Lat 9. There

was a question if the secondary road department or the drainage district should pay for repairs. The Supervisors decided the Drainage District should pay for the repairs as the road had nothing to do with the sluff in. If there is an instance of this again the Drainage District will pay for these repairs.

Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed drainage matters including DD 18 Lat 11 project. The sand under the railroad is making it difficult to find a good place to bore under. The current boring contractor hired can no longer do the project. A quote from a different contractor was received by Jacobson-Westergard, Engineer on the project. A change order will be drawn up and a letter will be sent to landowners.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to approve Change Order #2 for DD 11 Main Tile Improvement Project. All voted aye. Motion carried.
